**Fees for rating of the tournament results for ELO** in A, B, C, D, E, J, K (2,5 EUR per player), G1, G2, G3 (1,5 EUR per player) and F (10,5 for a team) charged according to the economic directive of the Chess Federation of the Czech Republic, **are not included in the starting fee and will be paid by participants during the registration.** The organizer pays these fees for players with GM, IM, WGM and WIM titles, the same as for teams composed only of players with these titles.

**Late registrations:** Those players (or teams) whose application will be registered after 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2012 will pay additional charge of 12,5 EUR in A tournament, 8,5 EUR in B, C, D, E, F tournaments and 2,0 EUR in G1, G2, G3, H, J, K, M, S, T tournaments. Applications for other tournaments are not registered and it is possible to register for them only on the day of the launching of the tournament.

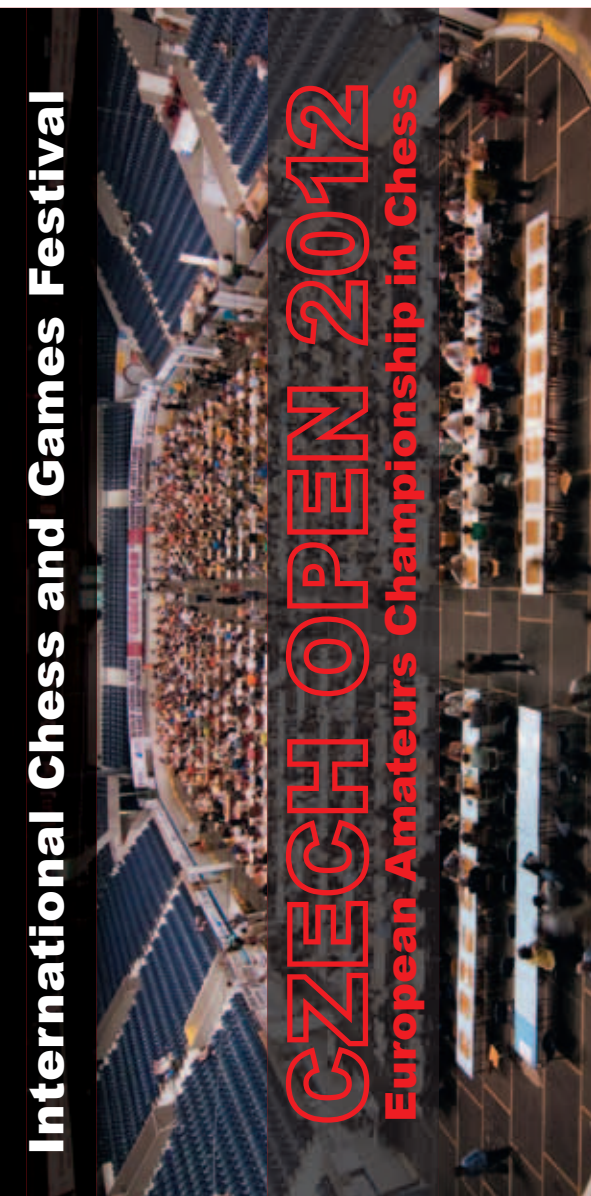
