- rating for FIDE, without limitations, max. 2 substitutes, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 1,5h + 30s/move

F) Open 4-member team tournament of youngsters up to 16 years

- players born in 2003 and younger, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2x 15 min + 5 s/move

G1) Open Championship of the Czech Republic in rapid chess - rating for rapid ELO FIDE

- without limitations, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 15 min. + 10s/move

G2) Open rapid tournament - rating for rapid ELO FIDE

- rapid ELO FIDE $<$ 2100 (or ELO FIDE $<$ 2100 for those, who do not have rapid ELO FIDE) or without ELO FIDE, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 15 min. + 10s/move

G3) Open rapid tournament - rating for rapid ELO FIDE

- rapid ELO FIDE $<$ 1700 (or ELO FIDE $<$ 1700 for those, who do not have rapid ELO FIDE) or without ELO FIDE, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 15 min. + 10s/move

H) Open Championship of the Czech Republic in blitz marathon – Otto Gutdeutsch` s memorial tournament

- without limitations, each player will play with all the other players (max. 24 hours) + possibly finals according to the number of participants, 2 x 5 min.

I) Open blitz k.o. tournament – rating for blitz ELO FIDE (with the exception of k.o.)

- without limitations, 11 rounds by Swiss system + k. o., 2 x 3 min. + 2s/move

J) Open rating tournament - rating for FIDE

- without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system , 2 x 1,5h + 30s/move

K) Open Championship of the Czech Republic in solving of chess compositions

- without limitations, solving system alike the rules of the world solving championship, possibility to obtain the international solving rating, 3 twomovers (20 min.), 3 threemovers (60 min.), 3 studies (100 min.), 3 helpmates (50 min.), 3 moremovers (80 min.) and 3 selfmates (50 min.)

L) Open Championship of the Czech Republic of bughouse

- pairs of players without limitations, playing system according to the number of participants, 2x 3 min + 2 s/move (so-called Bronstein system)

M) Open Championship of the Czech Republic of Fischerandom chess - Vladimir Novak` s memorial tournament

- without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2x 15 min + 10 s/move

N) Open super blitz chess tournament

- without limitations, 13 double rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 3 min

O) Open pairs tournament in rapid chess

- pairs of players without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2x 10 min + 5 s/move

P) Open pairs blitz tournament

- pairs of players without limitations, 11 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 5 min.

Q1, Q2, Q3) Open blitz tournaments series - 3 separate tournaments, rating for blitz ELO FIDE

- without limitations, 11 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 3 min.+2s/move

R) Open 4-member teams blitz tournament

- without limitations, playing system according to the number of teams, 2 x 5 min.

S) Open tournament in Raindropchess

- without limitations, playing system according to the number of participants, 2x 15 min.

T) Thematic tournament – Scotch Gambit 1.e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc6 3.d4 exd4 4.Bc4

- without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2x 10 min + 5 s/move

U) Polgar Superstar Chess World Championship

- without limitations, playing system according to the number of participants, 2x 5 min + 2 s/move

V) Open tournament in Basque chess

- without limitations, 6 rounds by Swiss system, 2x 10 min + 5 s/move

- both opponents play against the other on two chessboards, each game has its own chess clock and games are not influenced mutually in any way

W) World Championship in Frolov chess

- without limitations, playing system according to the number of participants, 2x 10 min + 5 s/move

Note: with players, who do not have even ELO national, the seeding coefficient 1000 is used*

Notice: All foreign players, who want to participate in tournaments rated for FIDE (which means A,B,C,D,30+,E,G1,G2,G3,I,J, Q1,Q2,Q3 tournaments), must have an assigned FIDE identification number (abbreviation FIDE ID or FID) at the time of the submission of the application form. If they do not have it, they have to apply their national chess federation for it.

C – 3 best players with ELO < 1700 (or without ELO FIDE) will obtain 800, 600 and 400 CZK

D – 3 best players with ELO < 1400 and without ELO will obtain in each of these categories 800, 600 and 400 CZK

30+ – 3 best players with ELO < 1800 or without ELO FIDE will obtain in each of these categories 800, 600 and 400 CZK

E – best teams with average ELO 1900 - 2099, 1700 - 1899 and < 1700 and the best team comprising only women will obtain in each of these categories 1 000 CZK

G1 – 3 best players with ELO < 2300 will obtain 1 500, 1 000 and 500 CZK

Discounts: young players up to 18 years of age, seniors over 65 years of age and women players have in tournaments A,B,C,D,G1,G2,G3,H,I,J,K,L,M,N,O 25% discount, these discounts do not refer to additional charge for late registration and are not added up.

Fees for rating of the tournament results for ELO in A, B, C, D, 30+, J (2,5 EUR per player), G1, G2, G3, I, Q1, Q2, Q3 (0,5 EUR per player) and E (10,5 EUR for a team) charged according to the economic directive of the Chess Federation of the Czech Republic, **are not included in the starting fee and will be paid by participants during the registration.** The organizer pays these fees for players with GM, IM, WGM and WIM titles, the same as for teams composed only of players with these titles.

Late registrations: Those players (or teams) whose application will be registered after 15th of June 2019 will pay additional charge of 12,5 EUR in A tournament, 8,5 EUR in B,C,D,30+,E tournaments and 2,0 EUR in G1,G2,G3,H,I,K tournaments. Applications for other tournaments are not registered and it is possible to register for them only on the day of the launching of the tournament.
